



**Directions
By Road**

From the South (via M1 and A1, or via A1)
From the North West (via M62, M1 and A1)
From the A1 Northbound, take junction 45 to the A64 East, signposted York and Scarborough. Continue on the A64 for about 13 miles, then leave at the A19 (York-Selby) interchange. At the roundabout at the end of the slip road, take the first exit (A19) and then continue through Fulford towards York for about 1.8 miles. Shortly after passing Imphal Barracks and The Fulford Arms Pub (both on the right) bear right onto Cemetery Road (signposted York Hospital). Follow Cemetery Road going forward through the first set of lights. At the next lights, bear gently right so that the city walls are on your left, and keep in the left hand lane. Go straight forward at the next three sets of lights, along Foss Islands Road, passing Waitrose, Morrisons and Halfords on your right and the River Foss on your left. At the next lights, turn left onto Peasholme Green. At the Black Swan Pub turn right into St Saviour's Place, then immediately left into St Saviourgate. HGF is on your right hand side, towards the end of the road.

**Directions
By Road**

From the North (via A1)
From the A1 Southbound, leave at junction 47. Take the first exit at the roundabout signposted York A59. Follow A59 Eastbound for about 10 miles to the York outer ring road (A1237) and at the roundabout take the second exit (A59 York). Continue along the A59 towards the centre of York for about 2.5 miles. Shortly after crossing the railway on the "Metal Bridge", the road bears left then right and you approach a T-junction with traffic lights. Turn left, and continue in the right hand lane to the next lights. Turn right into Nunnery Lane and bear left in Price's Lane, keeping the city walls on your left. Turn left into Bishopgate Street and continue over the River Ouse. Bear right at the next junction, then follow the road left into Paragon Street with the Barbican Centre on your right and always keeping the city walls on your left. Keep in the left hand lane and go straight forward at the next four sets of lights, along Foss Islands Road, passing Waitrose, Morrisons and Halfords on your right and the River Foss on your left. At the next lights, turn left onto Peasholme Green. At the Black Swan Pub turn right into St Saviour's Place, then immediately left into St Saviourgate. HGF is on your right hand side, towards the end of the road.

**Directions
By Road**

From Hull and East Yorkshire (via A1079).
From the A1079, cross over the A64 and follow the A1079 into the centre of York. At the city walls, turn right into Foss Islands Road. Go straight forward at the next two sets of lights passing Waitrose, Morrisons and Halfords on your right and the River Foss on your left. At the next lights, turn left onto Peasholme Green. At the Black Swan Pub turn right into St Saviour's Place, then immediately left into St Saviourgate. HGF is on your right hand side, towards the end of the road.

Parking

There is an NCP car park on St Saviourgate on the left hand side past HGF's offices. However, the access ramp is narrow and you may prefer to use The Shambles car park which is only slightly further. From the Black Swan Pub, continue straight forward along Peasholme Green until the mini-roundabout, then turn left. Continue forwards and you will see the car park entrance in front of you.

Parking and Ride

HGF recommends York's Park and Ride service which offers the opportunity to avoid city centre traffic and high parking charges by parking for free at five sites at the edge of York. Each Park and Ride site has a fast and frequent bus service into the city centre. HGF's offices are then just a short walk from the city centre bus stops.

**Directions
By Train**

York Station is well served by direct train services from most parts of the UK. HGF's offices are a short taxi ride from York Station.

**Walking route from York Station
(allow about 10 to 15 minutes).**

From the main Station entrance turn left along Station Road. At the traffic lights cross over Leeman Road. Continue forwards and then bear right under the city walls. Turn left and cross the River Ouse on Lendal Bridge. Continue forwards towards York Minster, crossing the road when convenient. Pass the Tourist Information Centre on the right hand side. Shortly before York Minster, turn right into High Petergate, keeping St Michael-le-Belfry Church on your left hand side. Continue along High Petergate which becomes Low Petergate. Continue forwards across King's Square into Colliergate, keeping Barritt's shop on your left hand side. Just before the end of Colliergate, turn left into St Saviourgate. HGF's offices are on the left hand side.

**Directions
By Air**

From London Heathrow or London Gatwick
Travel to London King's Cross Station in central London and take the train to York Station. The journey time from King's Cross to York is about 2 hours and trains depart approximately every 30 minutes.

From Manchester International Airport
Direct trains run from Manchester Airport Station to York at least every 30 minutes. The journey time is about 1 hour 50 minutes.
